Your <u>2022-23</u> Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) was selected for review in a process called verification. The law requires that we, as financial aid administrators, must complete verification before awarding Federal Student Aid. CFK must compare the information on your FAFSA to either the <u>2020 IRS Tax Return</u> <u>Transcripts OR the SIGNED copy of the 2020 tax return and all schedules</u> and/or with W-2 forms and/or other financial aid documents. If there are differences between your application information and your financial documents, your FAFSA may be corrected. Also, we may request additional information. You / Your Spouse must sign and complete the worksheet, attach any required documents, and submit to the Financial Aid Office.

• Complete the entire form. Do not leave anything blank. If not applicable, enter "N/A" or a "0".
