This notice serves as an acknowledgment that The College of the Florida Keys signed and returned the Certification and Agreement and assures that the institution has used the applicable amount of funds designated under CRRSAA and ARP(a)(1) and (a)(4) program to provide Emergency Financial Aid Grants to students.

The following information is intended to fulfill the reporting requirements posted on May 13, 2021 by the Department of Education.

The College of the Florida Keys will receive \$3,307,751 from the Department under the CRRSSA and ARP (a)(1) and (a)(4) programs.

As of March 31, 2022, The College of the Florida Keys has distributed \$1,283,035.94 to students under the CRRSAA and ARP(a)(1) and (a)(4) programs.

As of March 31, 2022, the College's estimated total number of students eligible to receive Emergency Financial Aid grants under the CRRSAA and ARP(a)(1) programs is 3,717.

As of March 31, 2022, the total number of students who have received an Emergency Financial Aid Grant from The College of the Florida Keys under the CRRSSA and ARP(a)(1) and (a)(4) programs is 584.

Students may apply for assistance by completing an application on the College's website. Student Assistance at CFK is to assist students with educational expenses such as housing, utilities, food, transportation, books, tuition, healthcare, and/or daycare that have been more difficult to meet due to the COVID-19 pandemic.
