Dear Parents and Guardians,

Listed below is the CFK Academy's dress code policy. Your attention to the dress code will ensure a smooth day. Should a student arrive at school not meeting dress code standards, we will either provide them with appropriate clothes to borrow, or they will be asked to call home for a change of clothes.





The standards of dress and grooming in the Academy are of utmost importance and shall contribute to the health and safety of the individual, promote a positive educational environment, and not disrupt the educational activities and processes of the school. Each student has the responsibility to dress appropriately. **Appropriate student dress at the CFK Academy is** *smart casual*. Academy students should not confuse this dress code with permission to wear workout

clothes, lounge clothes, yoga pants, sweatpants or pajamas to school. Clothing should be neat, clean and free of odors.

- The orange CFKA lanyard shall be worn around the neck with ID badge(s) daily. If students are DE, they will wear a CFK Academy DE lanyard.
- Shirts and tops must extend over the waist; no skin may be exposed at the belly/waistline. Shoulder straps on garments must be at least 3 inches wide. Bras must be always covered; no off the shoulder tops.
- The hemline of all shorts, dresses and skirts must reach no higher than the student's mid-thigh.
- Pants or jeans with rips or holes higher than 6 inches above the knee (exposing skin) are prohibited. All pants must be worn at the waist. Underwear and boxers must be completely covered. Sagging pants that expose underwear are not allowed.
- To ensure a respectful and inclusive environment, clothing that advertises or encourages the use of drugs, alcohol, tobacco, or weapons, or displays crude, vulgar, obscene, gang-related, or sexually suggestive wording or imagery, particularly that which could offend individuals of any race or gender, is prohibited.
- For safety, items that can be used as weapons (e.g., chains, spikes) are prohibited.
- No workout wear or sleepwear. This includes lounge pants, joggers, sweatpants, pajamas, tight spandex leggings, and similar items. Please do not bring blankets to school.
- Footwear such as house slippers, flip flops and athletic slides may not be worn. Preferred footwear are closed-toed shoes or dressy sandals.
- No garments can be see-through. No garments can be worn on the head including hats, hooded sweatshirts, bandanas, etc.
- Sunglasses are not to be worn indoors.
