



FLORIDA HIGH SCHOOL OUT-OF-STATE RESIDENCY WAIVER APPLICATION

Effective July 1, 2014 [applicable for Fall 2014 and thereafter], House Bill 851 [amended section (s.) 1009.26, Florida Statutes (F.S.), fee waivers] authorizes an out-of-state fee waiver for students who attended a high school in Florida, regardless of immigration status.

Applicants for this waiver must meet the following eligibility criteria:

- Attended a Florida high school for three consecutive years immediately before graduation from a Florida high school
- Enrolls in an institution of higher education within 24 months after high school graduation.
- Submitted an official high school transcript providing evidence of high school attendance as listed above.
- Student does NOT have 3rd attempt courses waived
- Student has NOT received more than 110% of their program courses waived

By signing this form, I (the student whose name and information appears on this application) understand and agree to the following terms:

- Receiving this out-of-state tuition waiver does **NOT** constitute classification as a Florida resident for tuition purposes and does **NOT** necessarily qualify me for such classification in the future.
- I must apply for this waiver every term at the Enrollment Services office by the posted deadline.
- Use of this waiver makes student ineligible for state financial aid such as Bright Futures
