



VETERAN OUT-OF-STATE RESIDENCY WAIVER APPLICATION

(Veteran does not need to use VA educational benefits – no certificate of eligibility is required)

Effective July 1, 2014 (not retroactive), House Bill 7015 [amended section (s.) 1009.26, Florida Statutes (F.S.), fee waivers] created the Congressman C.W. Bill Young Veteran Tuition Waiver Program, which authorized an out-of-state fee waiver for honorably discharged veterans of the United States (U.S.) Armed Forces, U.S. Reserve Forces or the National Guard who physically reside in Florida.

Applicants for this waiver must meet the following eligibility criteria:

- Student has submitted the appropriate documentation to the Enrollment Services office
 - Form DD-214
 - They have been honorably discharged
 - They physically reside in Florida (present FL driver license or FL Identification card as proof) while enrolled in the institution
- Student is enrolled full-time or part-time in a program that provides a degree or certificate
- Student does NOT have 3rd attempt courses waived
- Student has NOT received more than 110% of their program credit hours waived

By signing this form, I (the student whose name and information appears on this application) understand and agree to the following terms:

- a) Receiving this out-of-state tuition waiver does **NOT** constitute classification as a Florida resident for tuition purposes and does **NOT** necessarily qualify me for such classification in the future.
- b) I must apply for this waiver every term at the Enrollment Services office by the posted deadline.
