



DENTAL ASSISTANT PROGRAM

The 60 hour Dental Assisting Program prepares students for entry level positions in one of the fastest growing health care positions: Dental Assisting. The purpose of this course is to familiarize the student with all areas of pre-clinical dental assisting and provide training in the professional skills required to function as an assistant in the dental practice.

This course covers the following key areas and topics:

Administrative Aspects

- History of dentistry and dental assisting
- Introduction to the dental office
- Legal aspects of dentistry policies and guidelines

Clinical Aspects

- Introduction to oral anatomy
- Dental operatory
- Dental equipment
- Introduction to tooth structure
- Primary and permanent teeth
- Oral cavity and related structures
- Proper patient positioning
- Dental hand-pieces
- Sterilization
- and other areas

In addition to entry level administrative jobs, this course is ideal for students interested in pursuing a future formal Dental Hygienist program.
