

PHLEBOTOMY TECHNICIAN

This 90 hour Phlebotomy Technician Program prepares professionals to collect blood specimens from clients for the purpose of laboratory analysis. Students will become familiar with all aspects related to blood collection and develop comprehensive skills to perform venipunctures completely and safely. Classroom and lab work includes:

Terminology

Anatomy and physiology

Blood collection procedures

Specimen hands-on practice

Training in skills and techniques to perform puncture methods

Although not required for employment in Phlebotomy, as a student of this approved Phlebotomy program you have the opportunity to sit for the National Healthcareer Association's (NHA) Certified Phlebotomy Technician (CPT) Exam.

In addition to completing this approved Phlebotomy Technician program, a student must complete successful venipunctures and successful skin punctures in class to sit for the NHA Phlebotomy certification exam.

Additionally, the NHA requires that you have a high school diploma or a GED equivalent.

After passing the certification exam, certification is valid for two years. It is required to complete 5 annual Continuing Education credits through the NHA's Annual Continuing Education Program.
