



CLINICAL MEDICAL ASSISTANT

This program is intended for students who want to prepare for an exciting, challenging and rewarding career in healthcare. This program will train students to assist physicians by performing functions related to the clinical responsibilities in a medical office.

Instruction includes among other things:

- preparing patients for examination and treatment
- routine laboratory procedures
- diagnostic testing
- technical aspects of phlebotomy and the cardiac life cycle

Students will review important topics including:

- phlebotomy, pharmacology
- proper use and administration of medications
- taking and documenting vital signs
- cardiology including proper lead placements
- professional workplace behavior
- ethics and the legal aspects of healthcare



This program includes 140 hours of classroom lecture, hands on labs and a clinical externship opportunity (additional 160 hours) at a local healthcare provider. To be eligible for the clinical rotation, students must successfully complete the 140 hour program, submit to a thorough background check, drug screening and
