





What is financial aid? Financial assistance that helps a student bridge the gap between the student's funding ability and the Cost of Attendance. Cost of Attendance is based on tuition and fees, room and board, books and supplies, and transportation. Financial Aid includes grants, loans, work-study, and scholarships



Federal Loans

Direct Loans

- Subsidized No interest while enrolled at least half-time
- Unsubsidized Interest charged but no payment required
- Annual limits: \$5,500 for 1st year students
- The current interest rate is 4.99%
- Must be enrolled a minimum of 6 credit hours to be eligible

PLUS Loans (Parent Loan for Undergraduate Students)

- Credit Based
- Up to Cost of Attendance, minus any other aid student is receiving
- The current interest rate is 7.54%.
