By initialing below, both student and parent confirm understanding of all student expectations for parking on the CFKA campus. To renew or receive a parking decal, please bring a copy of the student's driver license, car registration and insurance card with this completed form.

1. Parking on school grounds is a privilege, not a right. Parking is available on a first-come, first served basis.

2. **Students must park in the designated student parking areas only.** The parking decal must be posted on the back, driver's side windshield.

3. In accordance with MCSD and CFK Policies and state law, students parking on campus have consented to a reasonable search of their vehicles. Possession of any contraband items in a vehicle will be construed as possession by the driver/owner of the subject vehicle and may result in out-of-school suspension and loss of parking privileges.

4. The student parking lot is off-limits to students during the school day. The only exception is if you're a DE student going to/from a college class. Students who go to their car during the school day without permission from administration will face disciplinary action which may include loss of parking privileges. Cars are not lockers.

5. Violations that may result in loss of parking privileges and/or other disciplinary action:
 - a. Any student who leaves campus without permission for any reason.
 - b. Aiding other students in leaving campus without permission.
 - c. Reckless and/or unsafe driving while on campus by passing illegally, driving on the grass, not yielding to buses, or any other type of careless driving.
 - d. In accordance with MCSD and CFK Policies, parking penalties may be incurred for any violations. Examples of these types of infractions are skipping school/classes, habitual tardies to class or school, disruptive behavior, chronic offenders, Level 3 offenses, etc.

6. Students are expected to be parked in enough time to make it to 1st period before the start of the school day. Students are expected to plan accordingly and take account for traffic and weather conditions.
